- In B above, the route can be walked the whole way on tarmac or on the wide parallel off-road rugged terrain footpath.
- In C above, the end point of this route is at The Packhorse Bridge which is the nearest crossing point long after the end of the reservoir.
- In D above this means from the Dam to Car Park 5 (Errwood Hall) only. From this point see Y above.
- In N above this steep, rugged, interesting route climbs directly to The Tors and joins The Tors 973 metres from Shining Tor.
- In Y above this includes two interesting detour options off-road (no cars).
